**WHY WE LIKE IT**

Hidden away in what was once known as "Little Hong Kong," Crown Wine Cellars is the perfect hideaway for both wine enthusiasts and novices alike. Located in Shouson Hill, Deep Water Bay, Crown Wine Cellars won an award for conservation due to the surrounding stunning greenery parkland. Within the grounds you will find six underground cellars and two underground bunkers, originally completed in 1937 by the British Military to provide storage for weapons and ammunition for World War II, as well as a newly constructed conservatory. To enjoy this modern-day historical fusion your best bet is to be taken in by a member, but the club also provides tours on the third Saturday of every month (check out the webpage for details www.crownwinecellars.com). GETTING THERE

Take a taxi through the Aberdeen Tunnel toward Aberdeen. Take exit 4, merging onto Wong Chuk Hang Road and turn left when you get to Shouson Hill Road. Turn left again when you get to Shouson Hill Road East and make a final left at Deep Water Bay Road. Crown Wine Cellars is on your left hand side.
